This map contains all of the above locations (including airport, mail railway station and city center).

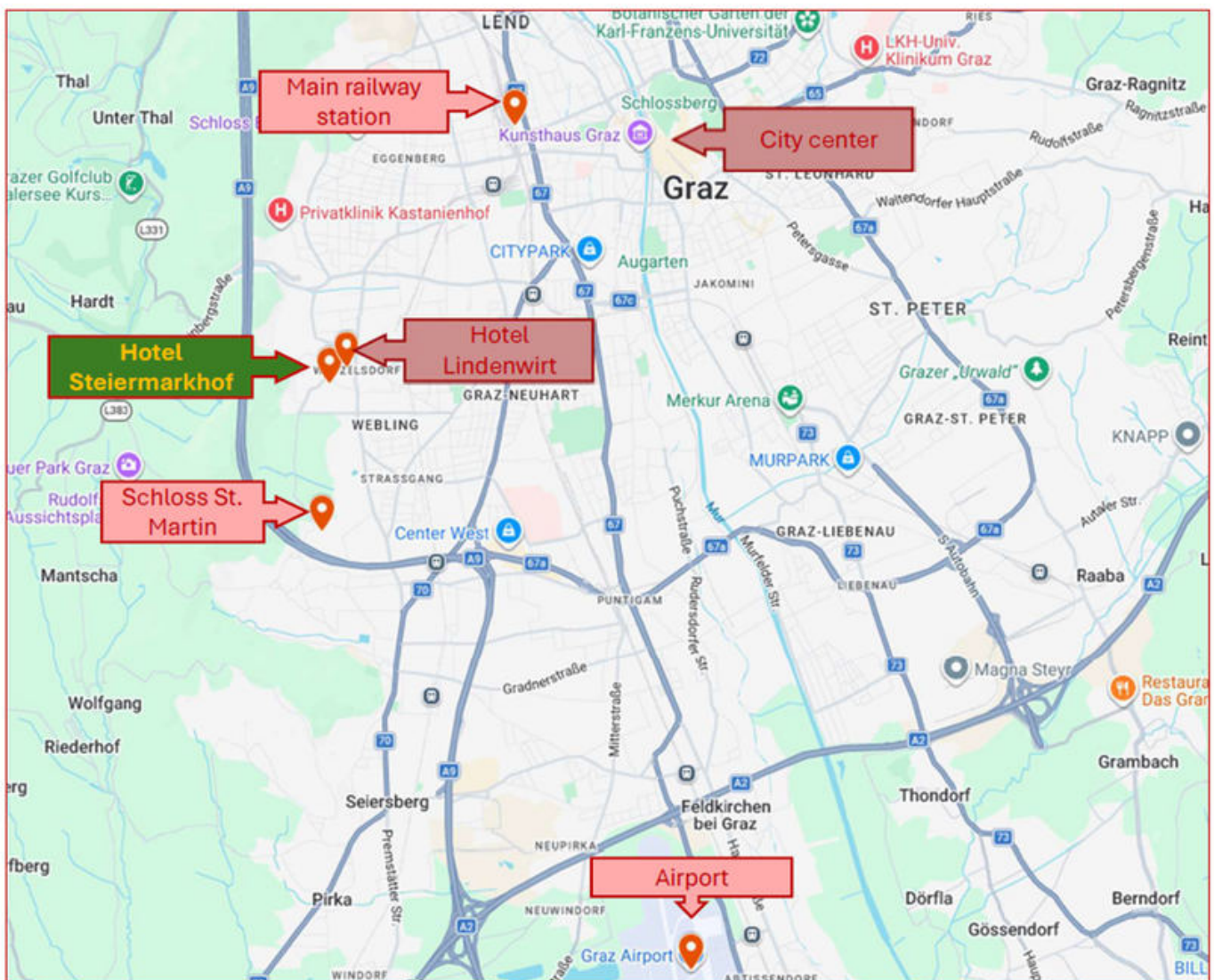

Public transport

The meeting venue is easily accessible via public transport:

From Airport Graz-Thalerhof

- The bus stop (Graz Airport) is located directly in front of the passenger terminal, in the immediate vicinity of the departure area. Take "Regio Bus 630" to "Graz Puntigam Bahnhof", change to train S6 to Graz Hauptbahnhof; about 22 minutes
- The train station (Graz Airport/Feldkirchen, S-Bahn line S1) is approx. 300 m and a few minutes' walk from the terminal. Take the train to "Graz Hauptbahnhof" (main railway station); about 15 minutes

- About 30 minutes to Hotel Steiermarkhof
- Take bus number "52 - Zentralfriedhof" to bus station "Hohenstaufengasse / Citypark" (after 5 bus stops), change to bus "66 - Grottenhofstraße", get off at stop "Steiermarkhof" (9 bus stops), 200 m to walk to Hotel Steiermarkhof

or

- take bus "62 - Puntigam", get off at stop "Peter-Rossegger-Straße" (after 13 bus stops) and walk about 500 m to Hotel Steiermarkhof
